

# Letters Between Us

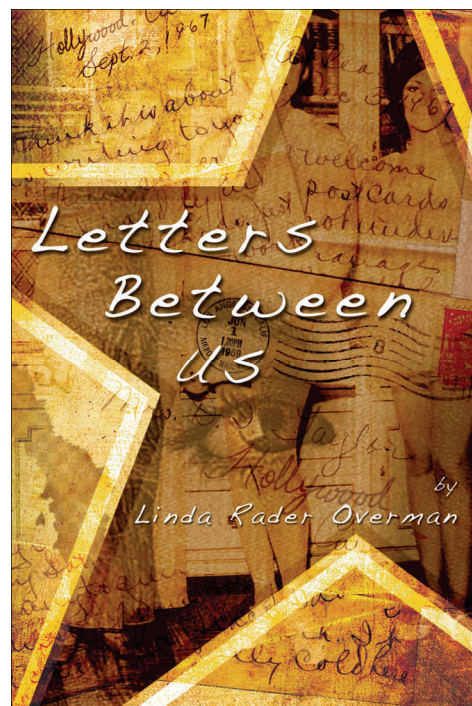
Secrets from letters are exposed on October 6, 2008!
